If I had to sum up this year's Confirmation class in one word, it would be "Questions"! They LOVE to ask questions, and they care about the answers. They want to know who God is, what God has done (and is doing), and how He calls us to participate in the ministry He is already doing. And they want to know who they are, claimed and chosen by God Himself to be God's own beloved children. Of course, more than often, the answers to their questions often lead to MORE (and even deeper) questions. And those "back and forth" questions, answers, and more questions leads them to wrestle with God, just like God calls (and names) His own people, Israel, to do so. (Genesis 32:28) Sometimes, it's difficult to wrestle with God, and continue to wonder who God is and who we are. But that wrestling... asking questions, listening for answers in Holy Scripture, and asking more questions... leads us to grow in our understanding of who God is, and who we are, and also allows us to grow in our faith, wisdom, and love for God.

I'm proud of this year's Confirmation class for their willingness to continually wrestle with God, and I've seen them grow not only in faith, but also in wisdom and understanding, which will serve them well as they grow into their adulthood. Please pray for our Confirmation students, and if you're able, please come to worship and our Potluck luncheon on May 19 to give thanks to God and to celebrate with our wonderful students. Thanks be to God for the gift of being able to wrestle with God Himself!

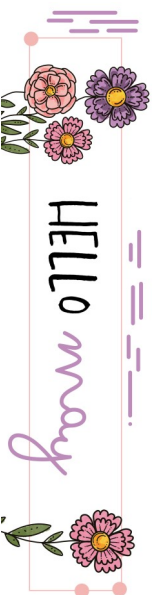

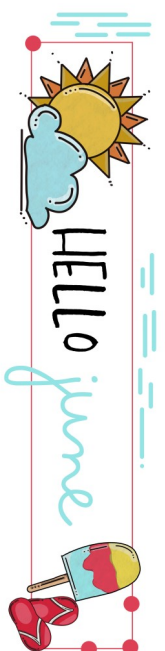
