Happy New Year!

On January 7, we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord Jesus. And in our Baptism,

we remember that it is God who chooses us, not the other way around. One of the reasons Lutherans baptize infants is because infants can't do anything to "earn" their Baptism. In our Baptism, God chooses, adopts, and claims us as His own children.

Just as children can't choose their parents, in the same way, in our Baptism, God chooses us even before we can choose God. And God chooses to be our Heavenly Father even if (and when) we choose to run away from God or give up on God.

How many of our brothers and sisters in Christ, including ourselves, fall into the trap of thinking that we choose God, versus the promise that God chooses us? Jesus said to his disciples: "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide." (John 15:16). And St. Paul writes: "For God chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight..." (Ephesians 1:4).

And this same God who chooses us doesn't leave our side, no matter what. Even if we run away from God, give up on God, or give up on ourselves. That's the nature of God's love for us, and it's never too late for us to live in the joy of being one of God's children. Thanks be to God! Now, please, go and share that good news, because we all desperately need to hear it!
