Do you feel run down,
anxious, overworked,
stressed, overtired, or
downright frazzled? Maybe
a trip to the gym, the spa, or

a nice hike in the woods might help to clear your mind. Another great opportunity is what we refer to as "Holy Week": the week leading up to Easter Sunday (including Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday). How would going to worship during Holy Week be anything like going to the gym, the spa, or the great outdoors? Holy Week is a time where we immerse ourselves in 2 major questions that define our identity: who is God?, and who are we? Rather than just "existential thinking", worship during Holy Week allows us to step back from all of the worries and stress of our everyday life, and re-center ourselves on our identity, both individually and collectively. And we do so in a way that invites us to face all of our daily responsibilities (at home, at work, and everywhere we go) with an entirely new viewpoint. In fact, when Jesus shared that message with people over 2000 years ago, it completely changed their lives, and freed them from so many of the hardships they were facing. And that message does the same for us today as well.

If you <u>like</u> feeling run down, anxious, overworked, stressed, overtired, or downright frazzled, I'd advise you don't come to worship during Holy Week. Otherwise, you might walk away with a completely new viewpoint, and find yourself with more joy and peace than you'd ever imagined. But if you want to find the joy and peace that only God can provide, we invite you to join us for worship. This message isn't just for you. It's also for your neighbors, friends, coworkers, and anyone else who's feeling overwhelmed. At Jesus' table, all are welcome. Thanks be to God!
