The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22nd, and runs for <u>40 days</u> (excluding Sundays) until we reach Easter

Sunday, April 9th. It's a time of prayer, reflection, and Bible Study, where we focus on what it really means to be disciples of Jesus in our daily lives. And it's something that we do both <u>individually</u>, and together, as the body of Christ.

<u>Individually</u>, I invite you to access a free <u>daily</u> <u>Lenten Devotional Booklet</u> offered by Luther Seminary in Minnesota. We have <u>a link</u> to that booklet <u>on our website</u> at stmatthiasgreensburg.org. Each day has a Bible verse, a short reflection, and a prayer for us to contemplate each day during Lent. If you <u>don't have internet access</u> and would like a <u>hardcopy</u> of the daily Lenten Devotional Booklet, please contact Pastor Paul or the church office, and we'll make a hardcopy for you.

I also encourage you to continue (or begin) taking a few moments to pray each day. If it's not something you do already, try praying briefly when you wake up and before you go to sleep. It's a great way to begin and end each day. And if you're not sure how to pray, that's ok! Just give me a call, text, or email, and I'll be happy to give you some ideas, or even give you some pre-printed prayers for you to use. Together, as the body of Christ, I invite you to eat, worship, and study the Bible with us on Wednesday nights during Lent. We enjoy a delicious Soup Supper and time of fellowship at 5:45pm, followed by a brief and very meaningful worship called "Holden Evening Prayer" at 7pm, followed by our Adult Bible Study at 7:30pm. There's a special article in this newsletter that lists the details, and it's also written on the March newsletter calendar. If you're not available on Wednesday nights, we hope you can be with us on Sunday morning for our regular weekend worship.

I look forward to this opportunity for us to grow closer to God, both individually and together, as the body of Christ, as we pray, eat, worship, and study the Bible together. Thanks be to God for the gift of Jesus, and for this opportunity to journey in our discipleship together during this season of Lent!
