The 40 day season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 2, and we welcome you to join us that evening at 7pm, with worship that

includes the imposition of ashes.

Just what does "Lent" mean, anyway? It comes from a word that means "to lengthen", with the intended translation being "the lengthening of days". It's a time of growth as we, Jesus' disciples, walk with Him toward the cross. Growth requires change. And change, which can sometimes be very positive, almost always means the loss of something as well.

And Lent is no different. If we walk with Jesus on His journey toward the cross, we <u>are</u> going to <u>grow...</u> we <u>are</u> going to <u>change...</u> and we <u>are</u> going to <u>lose</u> some things in the process. So rather than haphazardly join Jesus on this journey, let's look at what we might lose.

Here are some things that Jesus often tells His disciples:

John 6:20 "Do not be <u>afraid</u>...". Matthew 6:25 "Do not be <u>anxious</u>...". Mark 13:11 "Do not <u>worry</u>...". If you want to follow Jesus, then you <u>are</u> going to <u>lose</u> certain things. Things like <u>fear, anxiety, and</u> <u>worry</u>. The question is... are you willing to let go of those things? Because Jesus calls us to a new way of living, and things like fear, anxiety, and worry have no place in it. I invite you to join us on Wednesday evenings in Lent, for our soup suppers, Holden Evening Prayer, and our Bible Study... where we'll go on that journey through Lent <u>together</u>... as brothers and sisters in Christ, with Jesus leading us. I hope to see you there!

The January 2022 Council meeting was held via a Zoom Conference call. Voting Council members Fred Oestreicher, Bob Wolff, Norb Georges, Lisa Pegg, Ryan Winslow, and Pastor Paul were in attendance. Our Treasurer, Eldora Crist, was able to attend. Our Financial Secretary, Eliot Moore, was able to attend. Lisa Pegg led the devotions at 7:00pm. The Preliminary 2022 Council Members Handout was reviewed. We welcome Lisa Pegg and Ryan Winslow as new Council members. Pastor Paul led the meeting for the first order of business, the election of Council officers. The only returning officer is Fred Oestreicher, who served as President for 1 term, and may serve in that same office again, if elected.

Council President Fred Oestreicher Called the meeting to Order. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the Council agenda, as presented. Motion seconded by Norb Georges. Motion carried. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the minutes from the December 13 Council meeting, as presented. Motion seconded by Norb Georges. Motion carried. Eldora Crist, Treasurer, presented the December Treasurer's report. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the December Treasurer's report. Motion seconded by Ryan Winslow. Motion carried. Eliot Moore, Financial Secretary, presented the Annual Financial Summary. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the Annual Financial Summary. Motion seconded by Bob Wolff. Motion carried. Pastor Paul presented his report for **December**. He attended the monthly Synod meeting for Pastors and Deacons. Our Synodical Bishop, Kurt Kusserow, is going on sabbatical from January through March 2022, and retired Bishop Abraham Allende is serving in his place during that time. Pastor Paul presided at a funeral for a nonmember on December 21. 5 persons have requested to become new members and will be invited to join our congregation during a worship service in the near future. Pastor Paul tested positive for Covid-19 on Sunday, January 2. Due to the short notice, worship was cancelled that Sunday. Our Church Council had a brief meeting on Monday, January 3, at 7pm via Zoom to discuss Pastor Paul's quarantine period and how to handle worship on Sunday, January 9. Council consensus was for Pastor Paul to quarantine according to CDC guidelines (10 days from the date of the positive test), and, as a result, Pastor Bob Hawk was asked to preside at worship on Sunday, January 9. According to the CDC guidelines, Pastor Paul is able to return to in-person duties on Wednesday, January 12. Pastor Paul continues to serve as Interim Pastor at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Greensburg for approximately 5 hours per week. His quarantine period applies to his duties with Good Shepherd as well.

<u>Communications</u>: Received notification that the paperwork confirming our status as being incorporated in the state of PA needs updated. No additional cost is required.
